Civil Aviation Requirement 10 (CAR 10, Second Edition)

Civil Aviation Requirement 10 (CAR10) has been amended and enforced with immediate effect. The amendments, insertions and substitutions in Civil Aviation Requirement are as follows.

2.10 Human Factors considerations

2.10.1 Human factors principles should be observed in the design and certification of radio navigation aids.

2.10.2 To achieve and maintain maximum efficiency in CNS system, regular training for the Air Traffic Safety Electronic Personnel (ATSEP) shall be provided.

2.10.2.1 Appropriate training plan, program, training manual, training records, training and OJT checklists shall be developed and implement by service provider.

2.10.2.2 The records of such trained individual staff shall be maintained so that qualification of personnel can be performed.

2.11 Type Approval of radio navigation aids

Sub-rule (1) of Rule 75 of the Civil Aviation Regulations requires that only those radio navigation equipment that have been granted type approval certificate by the state of manufacture, shall be installed in Nepal.

2.11.1 Only that radio navigation equipment which has received type approval certificate from the state of manufacture shall be installed in Nepal.

2.12 Installation, operation and maintenance of radio navigation aid

Sub-rule (2) of Rule 75 of the Civil Aviation Regulations requires radio navigation equipment to be installed and operated in accordance with the provisions laid out by the state of manufacture as well as the relevant provisions in this CAR. Besides Sub-rule (2) of Rule 31 allows experts from the state of manufacture of the equipment to install the radio navigation equipment in Nepal.

2.12.1 Installation of radio navigation aid

2.12.1.1 All radio navigation aid to be used for air navigation in the Nepalese airspace shall be installed in accordance with the instructions provided for installation by the manufacturer as well as the relevant provisions of this CAR.

2.12.1.2 Only personnel holding ATSEP license with appropriate ratings may install or certify the installation of radio navigation equipment. However, experts from the state of manufacture may be allowed to install the radio navigation equipment if they receive necessary authorizations from the Director General. The application request for this authorization shall be made to the ANS Safety Standards Department enclosing the applicable fee.
