
GEN 3.2 AERONAUTICAL CHARTS

1. Responsible Services

1.1. CAAN provides a wide range of aeronautical charts to be used in civil aviation. The Aeronautical Information Service produces the charts which are part of the AIP; all other aeronautical charts are produced by the Department of Survey. Charts, suitable for pre-flight planning and briefing, are available for reference at aerodrome AIS units. (Their addresses can be found under paragraph 3 below.) The charts are produced in accordance with the provisions contained in ICAO Annex 4 -Aeronautical Charts. Differences to these provisions are detailed in subsection GEN 1.7.

2. Maintenance of Charts

2.1. The aeronautical charts included in the AIP are kept up to date by amendments to the AIP. Information concerning the planning for or issuance of new maps and charts is notified by Aeronautical Information Circular.

2.2. If incorrect information detected on published charts is of operational significance, it is corrected by NOTAM.
